COZIRON RESOURCES LIMITED VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION FROM TRADING

Further to our request of 10 January 2020 for the Company's securities to be placed in trading halt, the Company hereby requests that the securities be placed in voluntary suspension in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2 pending release of an announcement in relation to the assay results of the Croydon Top Camp drilling program.

The Company requested a trading halt on Friday 10 January 2020 out of an abundance of caution given the very high trading volumes. The Company has received initial data from the assaying of samples taken from five of the 13 holes drilled in the recent Croydon Top Camp drilling program and awaits the data from the remaining holes. The results obtained to date provide an incomplete picture of the significant drilling program undertaken over an area 400m by 600m. The Company does not consider the initial results received to be material in and of themselves, and believes that in order to provide a complete assessment it needs to consider all the drilling results from the geology being tested.

The Company requests that the voluntary suspension end on the date the anticipated announcement referred to above is released to the market which will be as soon as possible following receipt of the final drilling data. The final batch of samples is currently scheduled to be processed by Bureau Veritas between 18 and 23 January 2020.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted, or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the suspension.
