## Data from ZTEM helicopter geophysical survey received

Geopacific Resources NL (ASX: GPR) is pleased to report that all of the data collected from the ZTEM (helicopter borne AFMAG Z-axis Tipper electromagnetic) survey undertaken at the Company's Fiji Project areas by Geotech Ltd have been received and are currently under evaluation by Geopacific's geophysics consultants Southern Geoscience Consultants (SGC) of Perth.

During August Geotech Ltd carried out a helicopter-borne geophysical survey for Geopacific over the Nabila, Nadi South, Vuda, Raki Raki, and Cakaundrove areas located on the islands of Viti Levu and Vanua Levu, Fiji. Principal geophysical sensors included a Z-Axis Tipper electromagnetic (ZTEM) system, and a caesium magnetometer. Ancillary equipment included a GPS navigation system and a radar altimeter. A total of 2327.7 line kilometres of geophysical data were acquired during the survey which covered a total area of 910 square kilometres. Preliminary and final data processing, including generation of finalise digital data and map products were undertaken by Geotech Ltd. Data processing was undertaken in a Geosoft<sup>TM</sup> environment.

SGC are undertaking a full evaluation of the ZTEM database to reprocess the data into MapInfo software and to incorporate geology, structure, previous geophysical survey results, geochemical surveys and location of known mineralisation as well as exploration data for each area. SGC will detail and prioritise each of the anomalies defined by the work to enable ground follow-up programs to be planned. SGC expect to complete this work in early February 2011.
