

Woodlark Village Relocation

"We deeply value our relationship with the Woodlark community and fully acknowledge that there is an issue with the design of the one bedroom dwelling. We are working hard with the MRA in Papua New Guinea and are committed to jointly ensure a professional and timely resolution. A strategy is already being developed to utilise these smaller dwellings for community outcomes such as women's centres, children's libraries and other worthwhile community objectives".
