**COMPLETION OF SHARE PLACEMENT – TRANCHE 1**

Geopacific Resources NL ("Geopacific" "the Company") is pleased to advise that it has completed the first tranche of the share placement announced on 17 February 2012 and which in total will raise up to \$1.2 million.

The first tranche comprises 3,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares and 1,500,000 listed options.
