Impact of Cyclone Seroja on C4 Iron Ore Mine

GWR Group Limited (the Company) (ASX:GWR) announces the following update with regards to Tropical Cyclone Seroja.

The Company's C4 Iron Ore mine west of Wiluna was not impacted by the cyclone.

Haulage from site to the Port of Geraldton was suspended prior to the cyclone impact on Sunday 11th April and it is anticipated this haulage will resume once roads re-open and power is restored to the Port infrastructure.

Geraldton was impacted by this cyclone and we are receiving updates from the area following the passing of the storm.

We are not aware of any particular damage at the Port, although large parts of Geraldton including the Port are without power. GWR have received some informal updates with regards to the situation in Geraldton and we expect to receive an official update regarding the power situation from Mid West Ports later today.

GWR were not due to commence loading their next vessel until 16-19th April, and whilst it is likely that this loading may be delayed it is not clear at this stage how many days delay will be incurred.

GWR will issue further updates as more information becomes available.
