• SCEE Electrical awarded circa \$50m of projects in iron ore sector

Awards

Southern Cross Electrical Engineering Limited ("SCEE Group") is pleased to announce that its SCEE Electrical business has received contract awards totaling circa \$50m in the iron ore sector in the Pilbara as follows:

- SCEE has been awarded further packages of works by BHP Iron Ore Pty Ltd at their Central and Eastern Villages as part of BHP's Village Security Project in the Pilbara. SCEE's scope includes upgrades to access, lighting, and monitoring systems and will continue to draw on capabilities from businesses across the SCEE Group, including electrical, security and communications services from SCEE Electrical, SEME and Datatel respectively. These packages are scheduled to be completed by June 2022.
- At BHP Iron Ore Pty Ltd's Nelson Point operations at Port Hedland in Western Australia, SCEE Electrical has been awarded the E&I package of works by principal contractor CPB Contractors Pty Ltd on the Port Debottlenecking Project ("PDP1"). SCEE's scope covers both brownfields and greenfields locations, with on-site assembly, installation, and construction verification of all electrical and instrumentation components in the nominated work packs. The works are scheduled to commence in May 2022 and are due for completion in the second quarter of 2023.

Commenting on the awards, SCEE Group Managing Director Graeme Dunn said "I am pleased we continue to win work in WA's iron ore sector which has been a very strong area for us in recent times.

In my belief to have won significant further works on the Villages upgrades demonstrates how well our businesses around the SCEE Group are working together in delivering this multi-technology solution."
