## **Construction Awards**

- Heyday receives four awards totalling over \$50m
- Works at hospital, airport, education, and residential developments

## **Construction Awards**

Southern Cross Electrical Engineering Limited ("SCEE Group") is pleased to announce that its Heyday subsidiary has received four awards across a range of sectors in New South Wales and the ACT totalling over \$50m as follows:

• John Holland Pty Limited has awarded Heyday the subcontract works packages for the design and construction of the electrical and associated communications, security and nurse call works for the Shoalhaven Hospital Redevelopment Project that is being constructed to deliver expanded hospital services for the Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District. The redevelopment will include a new emergency department, medical units, dedicated mental health unit, cardiology units, surgical services, and operating theatres. The project comprises early enabling works and then construction of a new seven-level acute services building of approximately 31,000m² with rooftop plant and helipad.

The works are scheduled to commence now and be completed by July 2025.

• Multiplex Constructions Pty Ltd has added an additional works package to Heyday's Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport project of which SCEE announced the award to the ASX on 1 November 2021. This additional works package is for the electrical and communications services associated with the Fuel Farm which is designed to provide on-site jet fuel storage for operation of the airport. Heyday's scope is to provide the site-wide electrical and communications services infrastructure and the services to the associated buildings and structures that support the operation of the Fuel Farm, comprising truck gantries, fuel pump shelters, a main administration building, control rooms, workshops, and stores.

Work on this package will commence immediately and is expected to be completed by March 2024.

In NSW, John Hindmarsh Pty Ltd working with NSW Education has awarded Heyday the design
and construct contract for the new Jerrabomberra High School. The school will feature twentyfive flexible learning areas including three support learning spaces which can be dedicated to
specialist support classes, outdoor learning spaces, and a multi-purpose hall including sporting
facilities. Upon completion the school will support 500 students with design futureproofing to





accommodate expansion up to 1,000 students. Heyday's scope includes the delivery of electrical, security, fire, and audio visual (including specialist hearing augmentation equipment) services, and a PV system.

The project has commenced, and completion is due in late 2023.

• In Canberra ACT, Bloc Pty Ltd working with developer Art Group have awarded Heyday the design and construct contract for electrical services for the Calypso Apartments which comprises 207 apartments and shared common spaces including rooftop gardens, gym, and sauna facilities, and is located along the light rail corridor on Northbourne Ave, Canberra City.

Work will commence in late 2023 and estimated completion is late in 2024.

## Comment

Commenting on the above, SCEE Group Managing Director Graeme Dunn said "The breadth of these awards demonstrates the skill and capability of our Heyday business.

In particular, the Shoalhaven Hospital Redevelopment Project will add to Heyday's extensive healthcare experience in both metropolitan and regional hospitals throughout NSW and the ACT, for which there are further prospective developments being considered in our business development pipeline."
