The scope of works in these contracts includes for the design and construction of electrical, communications and security services.

The new projects include:

- ATP Redfern Building 1, NSW stage one of 93,000 square metres of office space for Commonwealth Bank staff.
- The Ribbon Project, NSW 74,000 square metres development in Darling Harbour of 402 room W Hotel and 159 serviced apartments including the re-development of the IMAX Theatre.
- Greenland Centre Bathurst Street, NSW Sydney's tallest luxury residential tower with 479 apartments.
- Midnight Project, ACT Midnight will be Canberra's first high density development located along the new light rail route, consisting of a mix of commercial, retail, hotel and residential zones.
