## **Equus Mining Drilling Program at Los Domos**

Equus Mining has been informed by Government authorities in Chile of the requirement for it to stop drilling and seek approval for an Environmental Impact Statement (DIA), by reason of the total number of drill platforms that the company has drilled from, before it can develop any further drill platforms or execute any further drilling at its Los Domos Project in southern Chile.

Equus commenced its current drill program at Los Domos in January 2019 and will not be able to complete this program until its DIA is approved, which may take a number of months. Preparation of the DIA was initiated in June 2018 by Equus and is scheduled to be presented to the relevant authorities in April 2019.

While awaiting approval, Equus will be conducting further detailed mapping and geochemical sampling to advance the company's understanding of the large-scale Los Domos epithermal property, as well as advancing plans to initiate a maiden drill program at its Cerro Diablo Project, also in Region XI, Chile.

The Directors of Equus are disappointed at the need to temporarily stop drilling and are implementing actions to preserve cash during this period.
