# Explanatory Memorandum to the Notice of General Meeting to be held on 7 July 2021

## Resolution 1 Ratification of Prior Issue unlisted options - Listing Rule 7.4

On 1 December 2020, the Company issued 2,500,000 unlisted options to Guillermo Angel Chacon. The Board considers that it is reasonable to provide remuneration incentive to the exploration manager in Chile to align management interests with those of shareholders. The Board believes that the issue of the options to Management provides a reasonable, and cost-effective method of remunerating management by providing an equity-based incentive for their ongoing commitment and contribution to the Company in their management role.

The terms and conditions of the Options are set out in Annexure A.
