#### **Issue of Securities - Cleansing Statement**

On 28 August 2018 Peppermint Innovation Limited (the 'Company') placed 11,000,000 ordinary shares at 3 cents per share to sophisticated and professional investors. The issue completes 100% of the funds to be raised under an agreement with the Private Equity Gateway Group (PEGG) to place shares to the value of \$1 million with its nominees (such as the Smidge Digital Unit Trust) and other strategic investors.

#### **Vesting of Performance Options**

The placement achieves a vesting hurdle for PEGG (see the announcement of 14 March 2018) whereby 10,000,000 options may now be exercised by PEGG at 3 cents per share after the Company share price trades at or above 5 cents per share based on a 30 trading day volume weighted average price of Company shares (30 day VWAP). Thereafter 10,000,000 Performance Options shall vest in 2 months' time, 10,000,000 in 4 months' time and 10,000,000 in 6 months' time, which may be exercised after the Company share price reaches price hurdles at 10 cents, 15 cents and 20 cents respectively (based on 30 day VWAP) in accordance with the following table:
