


NEW WORLD MINERALS STRATEGY


Uvre Limited (ASX:UVA) is exploring for minerals that will play a key role in the generation and storage of low-carbon energy – "new world minerals"

The latest step in this strategy has been securing the highly prospective **South Pass hard-rock Lithium Project** in the US state of Wyoming.

South Pass complements Uvre's **East Canyon Uranium- Vanadium Project** in neighbouring Utah and gives the company exposure to a third mineral deemed critical by the US Government.











EAST CANYON URANIUM VANADIUM PROJECT

Close proximity to other uranium deposits and development projects






EAST CANYON URANIUM VANADIUM PROJECT

Recent exploration activities



- New uranium anomaly identified at Loya Ray prospect 2.4km strike length
- 5km East-West anomalous uranium trend identified in northern section of project area
- Prominent untested uranium anomaly named "Big Sally" identified in western portion of East-West Trend
- Field work (mapping and sampling) completed at Big Sally, Loya Ray and other prospects in November 2023
- Occurrences of uranium minerals at surface identified rock chips results due Feb 2024
 - Previous results of up to 1.7% U₃O₈ and 8.64% V₂O₅ from rock chips

Radiometric anomalies and uranium minerals identified at surface




Figure 1: 5km East-West anomalous uranium trend and newly identified Big Sally prospect from radiometric survey.



Figure 2: Carnotite (yellow) observed with possible uraninite or coffinite (black mineral) from the Stateline prospect during Nov 23 field mapping.




Figure 3: Loya Ray uranium anomaly over 2.4km strike identified through radiometric survey.



Lithium minerals (spodumene and lepidolite¹) reported historically within project area by US Geological Survey








SOUTH PASS LITHIUM PROJECT

Geological setting

- Approx 50% of project area believed to be archean granites and pegmatites
- Pegmatites at South Pass are highly variable, occurring in both the granite and country rocks
- Pegmatites observed up to several hundred metres long in vicinity of nearby faults and South Pass greenstone belt
- Minerals found within project area include columbite-tantalite, beryl, lepidolite, spodumene and sky-blue tourmaline¹
- Mineral assemblage confirms the potential for lithium-caesium-tantalum (LCT) fertility

UPDATE & NEXT STEPS

EAST CANYON URANIUM

- Mapping and sampling across various East Canyon prospects completed Nov 2023
- Significantly, over 30 occurrences of uranium minerals identified at surface
- Big Sally and Loya Ray Radiometric anomaly tested for surface outcropping mineralization, indications are positive
- Rock chips assay results expected Feb 2024
- Information from both mapping and sampling will feed into drill target generation

SOUTH PASS LITHIUM

- Initial geological mapping and sampling of half the known outcropping pegmatites completed Dec 2023
- Samples in lab awaiting assays – expected Feb 2024
- If lithium mineralization or pathfinder minerals are confirmed, grid soil sampling and interpretation of airborne datasets will be undertaken
- Planning for maiden drilling program will follow thereafter
