# WMG's flagship project...

- Under-explored Minigwal Greenstone Belt
- WMG holds the key entire Mulga Tank Dunite Intrusive
- Northern part of belt held by Duketon Mining (ASX:DKM)
- Mulga Tank Dunite covers approximately 29km² similar area to Kambalda Dome
   (35Mt @ 3.1% Ni) WMG 100%
- Tenure under-explored to date significant potential for exploration upside
- Highly prospective for Ni-Cu-PGE massive sulphide mineralisation
- Only 11 historical holes deeper than 200m nearly all show Ni-Cu-PGE sulphides
- Rest of belt prospective for shear hosted Au mineralisation
- Unlock with modern techniques and fundamental geology

"These preliminary drilling results suggest considerable scope exists for the discovery of large accumulations of disseminated magmatic nickel-copper-PGE sulphide mineralisation within the Mulga Tank intrusion and potentially massive nickel sulphide mineralisation associated with basal zones similar in style to the significant nickel deposits currently being mined along the Agnew-Wiluna greenstone belt at the Leinster and Mt Keith nickel camps."

**Chemistry** 

Magma must reach sulphur saturation to precipitate magmatic sulphide minerals


**Physics** 

Focuses the sulphide minerals to form massive sulphide deposits

Challenge now is "just" locating deposit sites!

#### 1. Disseminated Ni-Cu-PGE Mineralisation

Target: Conductor 1

Hole: MTD004

Host Rock: Orthocumulate dunite

Disseminated pyrrhotite and pyrite, up to 0.85% Ni, 0.35% Cu and 0.28g/t PGE



#### 2. Massive Ni-Cu-PGE Mineralisation

Target: Conductor 1

Hole: MTD004

Host Rock: Pyroxene and Serpentinite

Vein of massive pyrrhotite-pentlandite-chalcopyrite, possibly remobilised from nearby massive sulphide

#### 3. Komatiite Ni-Cu-PGE Mineralisation

Target: Conductor 1

Hole: MTD007

Host Rock: Komatiite

Spinifex ore, bladed komatiite in-filled and replaced by sulphides



## Multiple untested coincident anomalies...

- Building on historical ~\$2 Million dataset
- Recently completed high-resolution ground gravity survey giving complete 200m x 200m coverage over ~46km²
- Completed MLEM planning = survey commencing end July/early August
- Historical HeliSAM survey = map black shales and aid MLEM interpretation
- Historical DHEM = numerous off-hole anomalies
- Soil partial leach working through cover = aircore for shallow expressions
- Untested 8km<sup>2</sup> Cu-Ag-Au-in-soil along southern rim



# Chasing mineralised trends from neighbouring mines...

- Under-explored Merolia Greenstone Belt 90km southeast of Laverton
- Shallow cover and area held by private operators has hindered exploration
- Historical Lord Byron and Fish Gold Mines trucked to Granny Smith (80km)
- Lord Byron 160koz @ 1.0g/t Au NW shearing cutting BIF-mafic volcanics
- Fish 87koz @ 4.1g/t Au folding and thickening of BIF in mafic volcanics
- Historical lag and soil sampling multiple untested anomalies
- Very limited historical drilling in tenement all shallow RAB/AC
- Recently completed Heritage Protection Agreement with Native Title Party so tenement can now proceed to grant

Initial litho-structural interpretation suggests potential for both styles of mineralisation within WMG tenement





# Extensive shallow high-grade workings...

- Laverton Greenstone Belt 4.5km south of Burtville Mining Centre (ASX:FML)
- Shallow historical mine workings over 450m strike
- Historical production 2,074oz @ 50g/t Au (1902-1911)
- Associated with quartz veining and ferruginous cherts untested at depth
- Esmeralda Exploration (1985) 7 RC holes largely ineffective intersecting stopes
- Recent SAM (Sub-Audio-Magnetic) survey over tenement area
- Recent site visit to map historical workings and locate historical drill holes
- Test major shear structures and mineralised veins with RC drilling







- Extension of workings untested within WMG tenement


