

Sale of Slater Dome Gathering System

Entek Energy is pleased to advise the sale of the US based Slater Dome Gathering System connecting the now shut in coal seam gas (CSG) wells in the Slater Dome Field. The Slater Dome Gathering System is an 18 mile long gathering system that runs from the Company's Slater Dome Field to the Questar pipeline.

This sale is a critical achievement in the Company's continuing strategy to remove as much as possible any future potential and significant liabilities that could result from the ownership and operation of a US based energy assets, in this case a gas gathering system.

The Slater Dome Gathering System straddles the Wyoming and Colorado state boundaries and is an asset superfluous to the potential sale of the Company's assets within the Wyoming Niobrara Oil resource play. The system has been idle since December 2013 and was purchased on speculation of future drilling and need for a gas transportation system.

In accordance with US regulations, the Company performed in June 2017 the required pressure tests to evidence structural integrity within the System and comply with relevant State requirements.

Total proceeds from the sale were \$US100,000.

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
