

## Aircore Drilling Commences at Rockford Project




Figure 1: Area D Location

Legend Mining Limited (“Legend”) is pleased to announce that aircore drilling commenced over the weekend at its Rockford Project in the Fraser Range of Western Australia. The drilling programme will comprise 65 holes for ~5,000m and concentrate on multiple targets at Area D and the immediate surrounds, see Figure 1 for location.

The exploration focus has returned to Area D following a full review of petrology results from diamond drilling completed in July 2016. A drill core sample from 626.8m in diamond hole RKDD002 was shown to contain disseminated pyrrhotite/chalcopyrite/pentlandite (FeS, CuS, NiS) of magmatic origin in a cumulate textured olivine bearing ultramafic. These are considered positive factors and indicate that Area D could potentially be in a favourable environment for nickel-copper mineralisation.




Figure 2: Area D Proposed Aircore Drilling on Aeromagnetics

Previous exploration at Area D involved extensive moving and fixed loop electromagnetic surveying with eight conductors (D1-D8) identified, seven of which were tested with RC/diamond drilling. This work covered an area of 3km x 2km centred around a discrete gravity high. The proposed aircore programme will extend the coverage to an area of approximately 7km x 5km and test several aeromagnetic lows and highs, as well as the flanks of the gravity high, see Figure 2.

The drilling will provide valuable information on the regolith depth/profile, basement lithologies and the lithochemical signature of the basement rocks. It will also provide data to enable selection and prioritisation of areas for the next phase of our innovative high power EM surveys. The programme is estimated to take 3-4 weeks to complete with assay results expected 4 weeks later.
