Contract Award – Provision of Iron Ore Crushing and Screening Services and Train Loading Operations – Peculiar Knob Direct Shipping Ore (DSO) Project

MACA Limited ('MACA') (ASX: MLD) is pleased to announce that Southern Iron Pty Ltd (a wholly owned subsidiary of WPG Resources Ltd (ASX: WPG)) has awarded a 60 month crushing services contract to Mining & Civil Australia Pty Ltd (a wholly owned subsidiary of MACA Limited) at the Peculiar Knob Iron Ore Direct Shipping Ore (DSO) Project located 90km south east of Coober Pedy in South Australia.

The contract will generate approximately \$127 million in revenue over a period of 5 years and takes MACA's work in hand position to in excess of \$800 million. Services to be provided by MACA include crushing and screening and train loading operations. Mobilisation is expected in the first calendar quarter of 2012, while mobilisation for the previously announced mining services contract is now expected to occur in the third calendar quarter of 2011. MACA will employ over 20 people on the newly awarded works, taking its total peak workforce on the project to over 120.

The addition of this crushing services contract to MACA along with the mining services contract will allow MACA to provide a seamless delivery of product to WPG Resources.
