FY2016 Performance Rights issued in accordance with the 2010 Panoramic Resources Employee Share Plan ("2010 ES Plan"). The 2010 ES Plan was approved by shareholders at a General Meeting of shareholders held on 30 July 2014.

Each FY2016 Performance Right will convert to one fully paid ordinary share for nil cash consideration, subject to the satisfaction of performance and other vesting conditions set out in the Notice of the 2015 Annual General Meeting. FY2016 Performance Rights that do not vest will lapse immediately.

From 1 July 2014, the long term incentive (LTI) to executives and senior employees is delivered in the form of performance rights to shares such that the LTI grant of performance rights to shares form a key component of their remuneration package.

Each year, executives and senior employees are invited to receive a new grant of performance rights to shares under the 2010 ES Plan. The LTI value that each employee is entitled to receive is set as a fixed percentage of their annual Fixed Remuneration (base salary plus statutory superannuation) depending on level and seniority. The number of performance rights to shares to be granted is determined by dividing the LTI dollar value by the fair value (FV) of one performance right (as determined by an independent valuer).
