#### **Issue of Securities - Cleansing Statement**

On 18 May 2018 Peppermint Innovation Limited (the 'Company') placed 3,333,334 ordinary shares at 3 cents per share to sophisticated and professional investors. The issue completes the first tranche of the placement announced on 3 April 2018.
