RG8's portfolio declined -4.7% in February.² The decline was driven by weak Asian markets, although Hong Kong-listed Chinese stocks offered a partial offset.

February was a volatile month for Asian markets, impacted by geopolitical uncertainty, tariffs, shifting artificial intelligence (AI) sentiment and broad sector and country rotations. China showed resilience, supported by AI advancements, a marginally improving consumer outlook, stabilising property markets in some major cities, hope from the National People's Congress meeting, favourable valuations and underweight investor positioning.

Our gains were led by China internet stocks such as Tencent and Alibaba, several long and short positions in Australia, Japanese semiconductor stock Renesas and numerous Japanese shorts. Losses stemmed from weaker results in Japanese positions like Olympus and Shimadzu and share price reversals in several Australian, Taiwanese and Japanese stocks which had been strong positive contributors over the recent past, such as Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co. (TSMC) and Mitsubishi Heavy Industries.

Despite short-term volatility, we see opportunities to buy quality businesses at attractive prices. We remain confident in our fundamental, bottom-up approach to capitalise on Asian market opportunities.

Buy-back: In February, approximately 0.5m RG8 shares were bought at an average price of \$2.22.

Dividend: The recently announced 6.0c fully franked dividend for RG8's 1H25 financial results had an ex-date of 20 February and is payable on 24 March.

RG8 provides investors with access to an actively-managed, concentrated portfolio, comprising long investments and short positions in securities with exposure to the Asian region. In June 2022, portfolio management responsibilities for RG8 transitioned from the VGI Partners investment team to specialist alternatives investment manager Regal Funds Management ('Regal'), under an investment advisory agreement with Regal Asian Investments Management Pty Ltd. In November 2022, the Company changed its name and ticker from VGI Partners Asian Investments Limited (ASX:VG8) to Regal Asian Investments Limited (ASX:RG8) to reflect those changes. Utilising a fundamental, bottom-up investment approach, the portfolio leverages Regal's extensive experience, network and specialist investment team.

RG8 seeks to pay fully franked dividends of at least 6.0c every six months. **At an RG8 share price of \$2.14, the target dividend equates to a 5.6% annual dividend yield, or 8.0% when taking into account the value of franking credits.**³

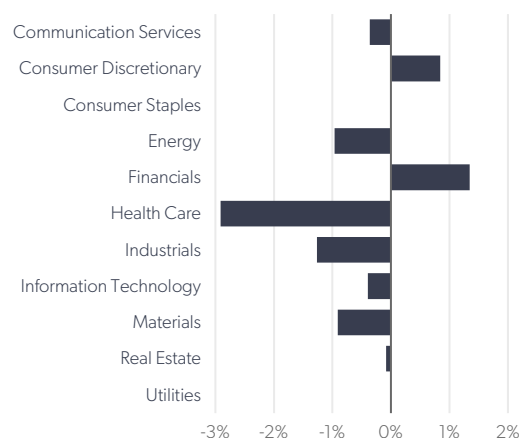

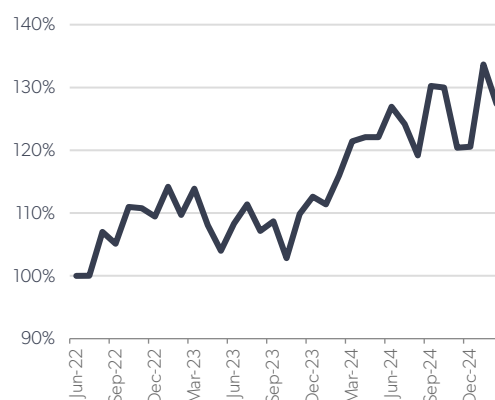
