Stallion Phase 2 drilling is scheduled for mid-May

Highlights:

- 24-hole targeted drilling campaign to follow up elevated TREOs at "Stallion REE" scheduled to start the week of 15th May 2023.
- Phase 2 drilling program is designed to expand on the exceptional drilling results received on 8th March 2023, including:
 - o STRC014: 23m @ 2,162.45 ppm TREO from 24m
 - STRC012: 15m @ 3,088.84 ppm TREO from 39m
 - o STRC011: 17m @ 3,783.4 ppm TREO from 61m inc. 1m @ 1.52% TREO from 73m

Summit Minerals Limited **(ASX: SUM, "Summit"** or the **"Company")** is pleased to announce that the Company is returning to the "Stallion REE" prospect on the week of 15th May 2023 with a reverse circulation (RC) rig to undertake a 1000 to 1400 metre, 24-hole drilling program.

The drilling is focused west of Ponton Creek. It will infill and extend the previously intersected rare earth oxide mineralisation (see 'Exceptional Drilling Results at Stallion REE Project' released March 8th, 2023). The Phase 2 objective is to confirm the recent results and to chase mineralised projections into the near-surface environments which are more amenable to shallow open-pit mining methods.
