The work has been awarded in two packages with the scope covering the installation and commissioning of all E&I works across process lines 3 to 6. The work is scheduled to commence in September.

The award follows the recently announced subcontract with Kerman Contracting and brings the total value of work in hand on the next phase of the project to approximately \$80m.
